At the beginning of the month, Felicia had visits with her cardiologist and orthopedic surgeon, and also received a new echogram and several blood tests. The blood has begun to slowly flow through the blockage, which is good news. On March 6, Felicia quit using a crutch, which was a huge milestone for her! However, 4 days later, the orthopedic surgeon seemed a bit concerned that Felicia didn't have much flexibility back, and told her that she needed to walk a lot to become a "normal woman again." As the month passed and more exercises were added by Lourdes, Felicia's PT, the flexibility is beginning to come back. Please pray for good results as Felicia gets

another echogram and sees her cardiologist during the first week of April.

Meanwhile, classes and Bible studies have been going very well. We have been averaging 65-70 students per week. Our studies of Mark and John have really opened up doors in sharing and discussing God's gift of salvation. We have students attending with a range of beliefs, and have heard that there is even a student who doesn't believe in God at all. It is very encouraging to see our students who have a relationship with Christ pour their hearts out to sharing about Him in small groups. Please pray for the students and for us, as we each minister to the other.

On the 19th, a team from the *George Greene Baptist Association* arrived in Lima, Peru! Brian had the pleasure of leading the

team to the four villages that were adopted. They led Bible studies, prayer walked, told Bible stories, ministered to believers, shared Christ with nonbelievers, prayed with people who were sick, and taught and loved on the children.

While Brian was away, Felicia had the opportunity for a brief visit at the mission office with Ken Rhodes, Missions Mobilizer with the Mississippi Baptist Convention, and Kevin Shearer, former IMB missionary from MS, who were making arrangements for a future trip with a group to Lima.

Sydney and Skylar both had a grand month of school at Fetzter. They finished their 8 lessons of swimming. The first week in April, they will be taking standardized tests, so
