On June 12, we finished our English classes and Bible studies and are taking "Winter Break," so that we may travel and help with the many groups that are joining us in Peru.

Some way, some how, we managed to keep it a secret from the kids that Brian's father, Glen (aka "Papa"), was flying in on June 16! And, what a grand surprise it was!

Skylar and Sydney finished up fourth grade and kindergarten a few days early, on June 18, so they could travel with us. Sydney and her three classmates wore capes and graduation caps with tassels at their ceremony.

On June 19, we packed up and headed 3 hours away to the little town of Canta, where we met over 100 other student participants, chaperones, translators, and other M's. This trip was marked as the first

International World Changer trip.

Thankfully, our kids roomed with Papa, which was a God-thing, because Brian and I was on kitchen duty. Most days, we got up at 4 AM and worked on and off until around 9 PM. Finally, all the food we had shopped for during the past weeks was put to use. While working in the kitchen, we met some wonderful, hard-working friends from Virginia, and we also began to form relationships with the kind and patient Spanish-speaking staff from the hotel. Although I can honestly say cooking is not something that I enjoy (Brian loves it!), it was an adventure in itself to be looking from the inside-out spectrum. God continues to teach us how to serve Him in other ways!

On several days, we were able to venture out and check on teams that were working in other villages and sites spread out around Canta. The mountainous landscapes were breathtaking. These teenagers and chaperones were awesome, clearing land sites, putting on a new roof for a widow, visiting schools and teaching/playing with children, etc.

While Papa was visiting with us, Brian was able to spend Father's Day and his birthday (June 25th), with his dad. We returned from Canta on Brian's birthday, after taking inventory of our supplies, cleaning up, and after the staff sang Happy Birthday in English to him. In Lima, Papa treated us to Chile's for Brian's birthday and returned back to the States on the night of the 26th.

Friday, July 2, we begin our second IWC trip, but this time it is to Huancayo, which is about a 10 hour drive from Lima. There will be around 100 participants, chaperones, translators, and M's. Although we will be buying and sending out lunch supplies, we will not be cooking this time. We will join part one of the five crews that will be ministering to the area. We will return on July 8. Please continue to pray for our travels, for all who will be sharing, and especially for those who will be hearing the Gospel.

We appreciate those of you who requested and shared information and videos about God's work here in Peru. Words cannot express our thanks for your support, gifts, prayers, and love for our family!
