BUEN DIA, AMIGOS! (Good Day, Friends)

We're sending you a big Mississippi "howdy" all the way from Lima, Peru!

After running a tad late on sending out this newsletter, let's catch up on the events that unfolded in May and our first week into June.

For three weeks, we have been shopping 2 to 3 days per week for the first International World Changer event, and we will be finishing up the purchases with bread, veggies, and fruits next week, before we head to Canta. Each day that we shop, we venture to 2 or 3 supermarkets and buy items in large quantities to feed over 100 college students, plus translators and team members, for a one-week period. People are beginning to recognize us not as just Gringos shopping, but the Gringos who buy a lot and clean out the shelves of certain items. We are having to package, store, and freeze everything that we buy. Brian has been very courageous and impressive, stumbling through the language to order quantities of meat and even to get it cut to specifics.

Two weeks ago, Skylar and Sydney participated in their school wide play, *Oliver Twist*. Skylar played as the villain, Bill Sikes, while

Sydney played as an orphan girl, singing in the chorus. We were very impressed with the students' performance!

May ended with a bang! Sydney and Skylar both had birthdays (25th and 27th), turning 6 and 10 years old. They celebrated their birthdays with friends at an after-school party on the 28th. We were quite impressed by the number of birthday cards they received from churches that sent cards in to Mississippi's WMU!

Intermingled with IWC shopping, school events, birthdays, and luncheons with several groups of summer missionaries, we have been traveling to and from our English classes and Bible studies. Saturday before last, a group of 6 summer M's visited our students. We broke into groups, and each group taught the English and Bible lessons that we provided for them.

We ended our intermediate level classes with the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ, sharing important questions and answers about having a relationship with Christ from a Scriptural standpoint, passing out tracts, and offering New Testaments. In our advanced classes, we are finishing up classes this week with training on how to share our witness.

This past Saturday, after many verbal and email invitations were sent out to all of our students and translators, we hosted a REAP North Cookout and time of fellowship. A group of 20+ summer M's visited and spent several hours in conversations with our students. We shared good times, as well as great hamburgers with all the fixings!

The teams and summer M's have already begun to pour into Lima and traveling to northern Peru! That means GOOD NEWS to people who are hearing the Gospel, some for the very first time! For us, that means that we have to be on our toes for all the responsibilities required for logistics of the translators! As we are finishing up classes this week, Skylar and Sydney will also finish up theirs next week. Then, we will begin our "winter" travels with teams!
