



Hola! We hope that this newsletter finds each of you doing very well. February came and went by quickly!

February consisted of several events, including Felicia having her second surgery and beginning rehabilitation, Skylar and Sydney beginning their second semester at Fetzer, Brian coordinating translators for the many upcoming groups, Felicia preparing and teaching EFL/Bible studies, and Brian assisting a team on a vision journey to several unreached villages in the mountains.

Praise the Lord! Felicia was able to have her 2<sup>nd</sup> surgery on February 5. The doctor removed the screw that was holding the bones together while her tendon healed. She has had 21 days of physical therapy, which involves icing and massaging the leg/getting out kinks in the tendons, exercises to strengthen her ankle, and learning to walk again. Yesterday's echogram showed a small decrease in size of the clots; they are beginning to break into pieces instead of being one solid clot from the lower stomach to the knee, which puts a risk of the clots breaking loose. The exercises have been postponed for now,

and elevation of the leg above the heart is needed for periods of sitting for more than 30 minutes at a time. Although this has put a hold on her progress in learning to walk again without a crutch, we know God is our refuge and strength. He is our Healer and is in control! She will see her doctors several times during March.

Skylar and Sydney are enjoying the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of their 5<sup>th</sup> and 1<sup>st</sup> grade years. They completed their summer vacation and started back to Fetzer on the 23<sup>rd</sup>. They were excited to meet up with friends, teachers, and to begin their 8 swimming lessons for requirements of their P.E. class.

Brian began his two online courses with New Orleans Baptist Seminary. In addition to his studies, reading many books, and writing papers, he has been working on lining up 27 translators for the 13 March teams, in addition to teams that are sending in their information for April and on.

On the 23<sup>rd</sup>, the EFL classes and Bible studies kicked off to a great start. Although we see many familiar faces attending, there have been quite a few new students in

each of the classes, traveling from many different places in Lima, and some even traveling from Canta! Please pray for clear communication and teaching of the gospel, and for students to be open to learning and receiving Him.

Brian traveled this past Monday night with a two-man team from Florida on a vision journey to unreached villages near Canta. On a previous research trip, he, Jim, and JB had found villages were open to the gospel, but one told them outright not to come. After much prayer, there was a turnover in leadership, and all the villages were VERY open and anxious to hear God's Word. On one of Brian's Facebook posts, he summed up the trip quite well, "Great trip!!! Doors didn't just open, they were blown off their hinges! Lots of answered prayers, and great ministry time yesterday and today!! God is so Great!!!! Thanks for your prayers!!!!"

Please be praying for our home team from George Greene Baptist Association. Brian will be traveling with them to San Jose, San Buenaventura, San Lorenzo, and Viscas from March 19-24. Pray for open doors and hearts.
