At the beginning of the month, Felicia had another echogram, and the results showed that instead of having one solid blockage from the lower stomach to the calf area, the blood is now channeling through the vein, and there are only 3 small clots left! Can we get an "Amen" on that one!? Little by little, the flexibility is coming back to her ankle as she continues in her exercises and physical therapy.

We were honored to have another team come from the George Greene Baptist Association. Our family traveled to the Chillon River Valley and worked in San Lorenzo, San Buenaventura, San Jose, and Viscas. Felicia was amazed at how many people had heard about and been praying for her after her fall. Skylar and Sydney enjoyed playing and ministering to the children in

the villages. It was fun to watch them use body motions to communicate. On two occasions, Bro. Jimmy Holcomb and several national partners hiked for several hours over the top of a mountain to visit 2 additional villages that are on the map. Although one of the villages seemed to be a ghost town because they travel to farm during this time of year, the team did have a divine encounter in the second village. The director of the school said he had a dream saying to get to the village early because someone was coming to see him! Continue to pray for the people in these villages--that not only will they accept God's Word, but that they'll also become strong disciples!

At one of our classes, two of the students / translators were seeking baptism, and God worked out all the arrangements to borrow our pastor's swimming pool. Brian had the honor of performing the baptism as these two sweet young women publicly proclaimed their obedience

and commitment to Christ. Glory to God!

As we praised God during Resurrection weekend, we also were blessed with several days of much-needed rest. On Sunday, we were invited to dine with REAP North M's; we had an enjoyable meal and conversation.

Now, we are busily preparing for Felicia's National Partner Hands-On Conference with 14 fellow translators and 2 national M's from Canta city. The team will travel to the Chillon River Valley, and the nationals will use their skills to evangelize the villagers. They will use storying, sharing their testimonies, door-to-door evangelism, and working with the children in the schools, as they teach and love on the people. We've had a couple of preplanning meetings, and it is amazing to sit back and watch as they create and prepare for the M trip! Pray for God to work in and through each of them, Felicia, and Jim, as they head to Canta on May 2.
